Camp Counselor Requirements

People Skills – Instructors must present an outgoing and proactive ability to interact with athletes, parents and other coaches. Must maintain a professional disposition and handle situations in a kind manner.

Moral Integrity – References will be contacted

Personal Growth– Coaches are encouraged in growth and development through leadership structured teaching and group interaction.

Compensation – Wages paid weekly and are negotiated and agreed upon prior to camp.

Other Positions:

Coach: Preferably a current coach or a parent with previous coaching and/or playing experience. Also included are current College or Professional players.

Jr. Counselor: This category includes High School students that have participated in 2 or more years of Quick Handle basketball camps.

General Assistant: This category includes areas such as working in the concession booth and other designated areas that do not include direct teaching of basketball skills to the campers.
